Harper Lee's Second Novel Sparks Debate

It's been 55 years since *To Kill a Mockingbird*. So why is her publisher printing a sequel now?



Longtime Harper Lee fans were shocked Feb. 3 when her publisher announced plans to release *Go Set a Watchman*, the sequel to her beloved 1960 novel *To Kill a Mockingbird*. Despite much excitement, some worry that the famously reclusive author's health is failing—and question the timing of the announcement, which came just three months after the death of the author's sister Alice Lee, who was

notoriously devoted to safeguarding Lee's legacy. "I'm alive and kicking and happy as hell with the reactions to *Watchman*," Lee insisted in a statement. The sequel—which is set 20 years after the action in *Mockingbird*—is slated to hit shelves July 14.

DEATH

Legendary University of North Carolina basketball coach **Dean Smith** died on Feb. 7 at age 83. A Hall of Fame coach and civil rights activist, Smith served the team for 36 years, helping to earn two national championships

and 879 wins, the fourth highest total among major college men's basketball coaches.
